*Schedule of Events:* **THURSDAY, JUNE 24 – PRACTICE ROUND**

There are no assigned tee times for the practice round. You may play at your convenience. An optional skins game and two-man best ball event will be played throughout the day. Additionally, the **4-Club / 2-Hole Challenge** will begin on #10 at 5:00 p.m. Ask any Golf Professional for details. There will be a Kick-Off Party that is open to players and their significant others starting at 6:00 p.m. in the Prestwick Room: (flight wagering, heavy appetizers, tee prize distribution and Gold Bullion signing.)

**FRIDAY, JUNE 25 – THREE NINE-HOLE MATCHES**

*Shotgun starts: 8:00 a.m. / 11:00 a.m. / 3:00 p.m.*

- \* After each nine-hole match, proceed to your next match starting tee
- \* Golf Staff will pick up your scorecards from your previous match.
- \* Begin play as soon as both teams have arrived at the starting hole.
- \* **Stop at the Practice Green during your match to chip off.**
- \* **2:45 p.m. putt for \$5,000.**

The tournament will begin promptly at **8:00 a.m.** (exact hole assignments are listed on the following pages) and you will play three consecutive nine-hole matches against the other teams in your flight. There will be breakfast available at 7:00 a.m. as well as a boxed lunch available during your second match. There will be burgers, brats and a beer tasting event starting at 6:30 p.m. at the Prestwick Patio.

**SATURDAY, JUNE 26 – TWO NINE-HOLE MATCHES**

*Shotgun starts: 8:00 a.m. / 11:00 a.m.*

Play resumes at **8:00 a.m.** where the two remaining matches will be played consecutively against the two teams remaining in your flight. There will be breakfast available at 7:00 a.m. as well as lunch after your final match. The Flight Winners and 3 Wild Card winners (the top 3 non-flight winning teams with the most points won for their 5 matches) will participate in a Horserace Playoff to determine the overall Member~Guest Champions at approximately 2:45 p.m. Starting at 6:00 p.m., there will be a Reception Party, Awards Presentation and Dinner for the players and their significant others followed by a Poolside Party open to all members.

## 2010 Shadow Valley Country Club Member~Guest

**Format:** *Round Robin Four-Ball (Low Net Ball of Partners)*  
Each team will play a nine-hole match against each of the other teams in their flight. A schedule of the matches is included. Matches start on the assigned hole and continue around the nine that you began play on.

The team with the lowest net ball on each hole is the winner of that hole.

**Flighting And Seeds:** Teams were ranked one (1) through forty-two (42) by adding together the teammates' indexes. Individual Handicaps will be adjusted to 80% before flighting. Flights were assembled by dividing the field in groups of six based on their seeds.

**Scoring:** There are a total of **NINE** points available in each match.  
Points will be awarded to each team according to the following formula:

Each hole won	1 point
Each hole halved	½ point

**Handicaps:** In each match, the handicaps of all players shall be reduced by the handicap of the low player in the group, who shall then play at zero. The shots fall as the scorecard plays.

**Ties:** In the event of a two-way tie for first place in a flight, the winning team will be decided on the basis of a head-to-head match between the two teams. If the head-to-head match results in a tie, the teams shall chip off to decide the winner. If there are two or more teams tied for wild card spot(s), those teams shall chip off to decide the winner(s). The tie-breaker chip offs will be at the Practice Green.

**Rules:** U.S.G.A. Rules are in effect except where amended by Local Rules.  
\* All flights will play from the Black tee markers.  
\* Participants age 60+ may play from the Blue tee markers.  
\* Concession of Stroke Decision of Rule 2-4/6 page 21. Concession of stroke **must** be taken. If a player proceeds to putt after concession, his partner may be disqualified for that hole.  
\* The 14-club limit is in effect.  
\* Stones in bunkers are moveable obstructions. Players shall notify opponents before removal.  
\* Ground under repair is marked by white lines and relief may be taken in accordance with Rule 25-1/b.  
\* All newly sodded areas (1,2,7,9) are to be played as Ground Under Repair. Player **Must** take relief, no closer to the hole, take a free drop.

**Inclement Weather:** In the case of suspended play, players shall mark the position of their golf ball and discontinue play.

### *Pace of Play:*

Please keep in mind the following guidelines for faster play: be ready to hit when it is your turn, pick up if you are out of the hole and play fast.

### *Determining the Member~Guest Champions*

### *Horserace:*

The Horserace will determine the overall Member~Guest Champions. The format will be a five-hole alternate shot playoff. Each team's handicap will be determined by halving the combined team handicaps used from the round robin and halving that number as well due to the alternate shot format. The holes that will be played are:

<i>Hole #10</i>	<i>#9 handicap hole</i>
<i>Hole #11</i>	<i>#7 handicap hole</i>
<i>Hole #12</i>	<i>#5 handicap hole</i>
<i>Hole #17</i>	<i>#17 handicap hole</i>
<i>Hole #18</i>	<i>#11 handicap hole</i>

- **EXAMPLE:**

PLAYER A 5 handicap

PLAYER B 9 handicap  $(5 + 9 = 14)(14 \times .5 = 7)(7 \times .5 = 3.5)$  rounded = 4

.1 through .4 = round down

.5 through .9 = round up

The team will decide prior to starting the Horserace which player will begin the 1<sup>st</sup>, 3<sup>rd</sup> and 5<sup>th</sup> holes and who will begin the 2<sup>nd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> holes. Five teams will be eliminated on the first hole, with one team being eliminated on each subsequent hole. A chip off will decide any tie after a hole is played. A tie after the 18<sup>th</sup> hole will be decided by replaying the 18<sup>th</sup> hole using alternate shot format until a champion is determined.

### *Putt for \$5,000:*

Each player will chip off during the first match to determine who will putt for \$5,000: The closest to the hole will be the player to putt for \$5,000. Please stop at the Practice Green as you pass by to chip. In case of a tie, we will continue to chip off until a qualifier is determined.
