



SWIM CENTER POLICIES & PROCEDURES

- Hours of Operation: 9:00 am - 9:00 PM 7 days a week.
- All members are required to check in when using the Swim Center. A sign in book will be placed at the entrance to the Swim Center when there is not a Pool Attendant on duty (we will rely on the honor system during this time).
- Note: The Parent/Guardian will be responsible for the actions of all individuals they sign in and/or take responsibility for.
- Guests must be accompanied by a member. The Guest Fees will be \$7.00 on weekdays and \$10.00 on weekends.
- There will be no food allowed in the Swim Center except in the designated areas (i.e. inside the Gazebo, at the tables by the Cabana).
- All Food and Beverages must be purchased from SVCC. All beverages will be served in non-glass containers. There will be complimentary water provided in the cooler.
- No Outside coolers of any kind may be brought into Swim Center.
- The Spa is reserved for persons 14 years and older.
- All purchases will be charged at the end of the day and receipts will be available at the Welcome Center desk the following day.
- Children under 14 must be accompanied and supervised by an adult at all times.
- No lifeguard will be on duty at any time.
- No inflatables / flotation devices (exception: arm floties for toddlers and noodles).
- No pets.
- No regular diapers or pullups allowed - Swim Diapers Only.
- No jogging, running, etc.
- No diving or flips from side of pool.
- No foul language.
- No climbing or sliding on the Mushroom or stuffing the top.
- No balls, kickboards, boogie boards or other like items.
- No throwing of any objects.
- Disposal of garbage is your responsibility.
- Parking - Anything other than SVCC Community Carts (Non SVCC carts, bikes, scooters, etc.) must be parked in the asphalt (concrete sidewalks are not open for any traffic other than SVCC carts) parking lot or on the street.

BEHAVIOR ISSUES

Behavior issues will be handled in the following manner:

1ST Incident: The Pool Attendant will stop the person(s), if a child(ren), the parent(s) or guardian(s) and remove them from the pool for 5 minutes.

2ND Incident: The Pool Attendant will stop the person(s), if a child(ren), parent(s) or guardian(s) will be asked to leave the pool for the remainder of the day.
