



THE GREEN SIDE OF THE VALLEY WITH JASON

The month of January finally brought some much needed rain, along with some unusually warm temperatures. We have been able to do a lot of work on the course during the winter months due to the warmer temperatures.

We have also been able to move forward on the short game area and should have the practice bunker finished early this month as well as having the green shaped in ready for sand and irrigation. If the weather cooperates we will be able to finish with the green mid-month and hopefully be seeding by the end of the month. The new practice area should allow at least two people to practice their bunker game at the same time. The chipping green will have a two tier platform that will be surrounded by Zoysiagrass in an approach style chipping area.

Other small projects that will be ongoing over the next month will be the raising and leveling of sprinkler heads around the greens complexes. After years of topdressing and thatch accumulation, many of these heads are an inch or more lower than level grade. This causes two major issues; golfers are unable to putt across these sunken areas and this also affects the throw of the water onto the green, causing poor and uneven distribution. The leveling of these heads will provide a smoother surface for players to have the opportunity to chip or putt over the area as well as give us better water coverage.

We have also begun to work on the lighting around the Clubhouse and along the main entrance. There were a lot of bulbs that were burned out as well as electrical boxes that have been damaged or have had water enter the boxes causing them to not work. These repairs will make a much better presentation coming in the entrance as well as the Clubhouse.

We have also acquired a new piece of equipment this month. We now have a heavy duty Toro Workman utility cart to help with all kinds of projects. The heavy duty cart is very versatile in that it can haul big loads of sand, dirt, gravel etc. It is also smooth enough for us to use it in our daily work such as changing cups, hand watering, etc.

- Members who have guest(s) that "sneak on" will be charged for a full round of golf and are subject to suspension of privileges.

COMMUNITY CART MAINTENANCE & REMINDERS

MAINTENANCE - It's very important that your leased cart is well maintained. Therefore, if you are leasing a cart we REQUIRE that you bring your cart in for monthly service. We will check the battery water level, check the tire air pressure and clean the cart. Your cart should be ready for pick up within 24 hours.

DON'T BREAK YOUR LEASE AND LOSE YOUR CART!!!

You are in violation of your lease if you are:

- Strapping kids in the bagwell.
- Allowing anyone not in your household to drive the cart.
- Stopping at a house during a round to get food or beverages.
- Letting kids without a driver's license (not a permit) drive the cart.
- Driving anywhere on the course without first checking in at the Golf Shop PRIOR to playing (and yes that includes at night).

The entry fee is \$25 for 10 rounds (5 additional rounds for \$15). Golfers must notify the Golf Shop before the round if they want their score to qualify. The top qualifier (highest score) will win 20% of the total pot and the remaining 80% will be awarded to the top finishers in the playoff. The playoff will consist of 18 holes with the top 8 qualifiers.
