#### **PAYMENT POLICY**

There are two options for purchases at SVCC:

- Utilize the credit card that you registered with SVCC to be kept "on file."
- 2) Present a credit card at the time of transaction.

#### CHILDREN'S ACTIVITY CENTER

The Children's Activity Center (CAC) is a great asset for SVCC which allows your kids to enjoy a great atmosphere and numerous activities while you take advantage of what you want to do throughout the rest of the Club.

In order to make the CAC experience the best possible for all involved, your help and cooperation is expected.

#### **CAC REMINDERS**

- Please allow enough time to sign in all kids and inform us of any outstanding issues we should be aware of relative to your child.
- Please DO NOT bring in any sick children (if they have a fever or otherwise are ill, you will be contacted to pick them up).
- Make sure all kids in diapers are "changed" prior to entering and provide additional diapers in their bag.
- Leave "personal" toys or other such items at home.
- You MUST REMAIN on SVCC property (not in the development or elsewhere) to leave your child in the CAC.
- Absolutely NO outside snacks/food will be allowed inside the CAC. Many children have allergies to certain foods (most commonly peanuts). In an effort to minimize the problem, our snacks are limited to Cheerios and Goldfish and we do not allow any food items to be brought into the CAC.
- Sign In/Out: Please remember to sign in your child's FIRST & LAST NAME as well as your SVCC location (fitness, tennis, golf, restaurant, etc.).
- If you DO NOT sign your child/ children in, there will be an additional \$5 charge added to your bill (daily and monthly included).
- Non-Member fees are \$7.00 per child for the first two hours and \$3.00 per child for each additional hour.

Please remember it's your responsibility to pick up the children prior to closing time, NOT the SVCC staff.

 Feeding Policies: CAC personnel will only bottle/sippy cup feed infants and toddlers. No solid baby foods.

Please keep in mind the CAC is a service provided for our members. Those who choose not to follow the rules WON'T be allowed to use the service.

#### PCC / SVCC RAYMOND JAMES ADULT TOURNAMENT

This will be the first time Shadow Valley (SVCC) and Pinnacle (PCC) have teamed up to host an adult tournament in NWA and it's going to be a great start to summer tennis! You can't beat the atmosphere at both of the clubs which makes the tennis that much better. The date of the tournament is Friday, May  $5^{\text{\tiny{IM}}}$  - Sunday, May  $7^{\text{\tiny{IM}}}$ , Friday will be exclusively at PCC for  $1^{\text{\tiny{SI}}}$  rounds then both SVCC and PCC will host matches on Saturday and Sunday. Cost is \$43.50 for first singles or doubles and \$28.00 for second singles or doubles. Events are Men's 3.0 - Open Singles and Doubles, Women's 2.0 - Open Singles, 2.0 - 4.5 Doubles and Mixed 5.0 - 9.0. Entries open April 24<sup>™</sup> and the deadline is May 16<sup>™</sup> by 11:59pm. #### THE GREEN SIDE OF THE VALLEY WITH JASON

The spring weather is upon us and is causing havoc on some of the projects we are trying to finish up. In between rains we have been able to finish leveling all the sprinkler heads at the green surrounds. We have also been able to knock out a little more of the low spot that runs down the middle of #18 fairway and anticipate having it finished by the end of this April. The Short Game Chipping Green and surround is very close to getting seeded. We have installed the drainage, gravel layer, greens mix and are moving onto the irrigation and the seeding process.

This month we are doing our greens aerification on April 3, which is the first Monday of this month. Our spring aerification will be a little different than the normal aerification of us pulling cores and trying to fill the holes with sand. We have opted to try a semi-new process called Dryject. This is a process of aerification in which we have contracted a company to come in with three machines and inject sand into the green surface down through the profile up to eight inches deep. This process will ensure that the holes will be filled with good clean sand from top to bottom, allowing better water and nutrient flow in the greens. This process is less abrasive to the greens allowing quicker recovery times as well as a better playing surface in a shorter amount of time. We will still be doing a core aerification on #8 & #18 in conjunction with the Dryject application as these greens need a little more attention than the other greens.

We are also planning to work on expanding and re-grassing some of the tees on Par 3s as well as some of the tees on hole #11. Some of these areas require more space than what we have right now and in order to enhance these tees we will be best served to creating more square footage. On hole #11 we have a lot of shade and trees that restrict the amount of sunlight and air that reaches the turfgrass. We will look at possibly re-grassing the top of the tee complex with a Zoysia variety that is more shade tolerant.

I hope you and your family have a Happy Easter.

We utilize multiple wireless cameras on the Golf Course. Property damage detected by these cameras will be used to prosecute the responsible individual(s) to the fullest extent of the law.

#### **GOLF COURSE & PATHS**

No one is allowed on the Golf Course (including cart paths) unless they have checked in with Golf Shop personnel. If the Golf Shop is closed, so is the Golf Course.

Any unauthorized activity on the Golf Course is not allowed and risks suspension of membership privileges.

Remember, Parents / Legal Guardians are responsible for Minor Children.

#### Personal Carts & Vehicles

Personal Carts and Vehicles will NOT be allowed behind the Clubhouse or on any cart paths. Personal vehicles may only be driven on the *ASPHALT* portions of the Clubhouse parking lot and are to be parked in the designated cart parking spaces.

Please monitor the drivers as many of you have expressed concerns about the "reckless" driving.

#### **COMMUNITY CART MAINTENANCE & REMINDERS**
